Children with a medical diagnosis, auditory or visual impairment, developmental concerns (Ages 0 - 3 years)

Any Baby Can supports families to help their children reach their potential through developmental services such as occupational, physical and speech therapy; specialized skills training; case management and resource navigation. Families and professionals work as a team to plan appropriate services based on the unique needs of the child and family, and focus on working with the child in their natural environment.

Any Baby Can is a proud provider of Early Childhood Intervention (ECI) services.

Children or youth with a medical need (Ages 0 - 21 years)

Licensed social workers provide medical case management to families of children and youth ages 0-21 years who have a diagnosis and medical need. Services are provided in the home. Service area includes Travis, Williamson, Hays, Bastrop and Caldwell Counties.

Children or youth who have/have had cancer or a blood disorder (Ages 0-21 years)

Licensed social workers provide medical case management to families of children and youth ages 0-21 years who have or have had cancer or a blood disorder. Services are provided in the home. Service area includes Travis, Williamson, Hays, Bastrop, Caldwell, Fayette, Bell and Burnet Counties.

First-time mothers (1-26 weeks pregnant)

Nurse-Family Partnership is a voluntary, free maternal and childhood health program that partners first time mothers with a personal nurse who helps empower mothers to confidently create a better life for their children and themselves.

Parents of children ages 0-4 years seeking parenting education and resources

Parent Educators meet with parents in the home to provide education and information on child development, parent-child activities and community resources with the goal for their child to be as school-ready as possible. This program used the evidenced-based program, Parents as Teachers. Service area includes Travis County.

Mothers seeking mental health support

This support group helps moms connect with one another and offer support, tips and a place to talk about the realities of motherhood. All moms, babies and little siblings are welcome. Offered at various locations and in English and Spanish.

Children or youth who need assistance acquiring hearing aids (Ages 0-20)

CHAT (Children's Hearing Aid Texas) provides some funding for children ages 0-20 years who are in need of hearing aids and do not have insurance coverage. The program serves a 20-county area in central Texas.

Expecting parents seeking childbirth preparation classes

This 4-week series covers the third trimester, child birth and the postpartum period. Partners or other support person are welcome to attend with the pregnant mother. Services provided in English only.

Parents and caregivers seeking parenting skills

Nurturing Parenting classes are groups for parents of children 0-18 years and cover topics such as positive discipline, setting family routines, stress management, communication with your partner or child, child development and more. This is an evidenced-based curriculum. Classes are located in various sites around Austin. Childcare is provided at some sites. Offered in English and Spanish.
