



Together We Serve

In 2015, we served **855 children** with developmental delays, chronic illnesses, cancer, and hearing loss. We also served **2,738** new and expecting parents, first-time pregnant women, moms and dads seeking parenting skills, and mothers with Postpartum Depression.

Although each story and each family is different, we saw children say their first words, hear for the first time, take their first steps, and win the fight against cancer. We also helped mothers prepare for the birth of their first child, and guided moms and dads along the challenging journey of parenting.

Our team understands that parenting is hard, and everyone needs help. That's why we're in this, together.

That number is projected to increase by **4,285 families**, or **12.8%**, by 2019.







Race and Ethnicity

Income




The Federal Poverty Limit (FPL) is a poverty indicator based on a family's annual income and size. In 2015, the FPL for a family of four was \$24,250; this is the basis for the figures portrayed in the graphic to the left. The numbers to the left reference the percentage of the FPL that families made, on average, in 2015, which is broken down into categories receiving differing amounts of government aid.




